2. Rules

- 2.1 The regatta shall be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020 (RRS),
- 2.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia (YA).
- 2.3 The rules of the Australian Historical Sailing Skiff (AHSSA) 10 Foot class
- 2.4 Any changes to the Racing Rules will be outlined in the Regatta Sailing Instructions.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Historical 10ft Skiffs recognized by the AHSSA.
- 3.2 Skipper & owners of competing skiffs must be financial members of AHSSA.
- 3.3 Entry forms (2 pages total) must be signed by the competitor.
- 3.4 Completed forms shall be received at the entry address no later than 18.00 hrs on Friday 27th April 2018

6. Measurement

Random measurement checks and inspections may be carried out at any time. A Boat notified of inspection shall follow the instructions of the Race Committee.

7. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available on Saturday 5th May and will be issued to all competitors upon registering.

8. Racing Area

The racing area will be as shown in Attachment 'A', of the Sailing Instructions. Starts and finishes will be adjacent to the rigging area at BSS as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Courses

The course shall be a windward and return style course (wind direction permitting), as described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. Scoring

The AHSSA Low Point system shall be used.

11. Alternative Penalties

Taking a Penalty rule (RRS 44.1) will apply, altered to one turn (one tack and one gybe) for breaking a rule of Part 2.

12. Protests

Protests will be conducted under Part 5 of the RRS.

13. Support Boats

The Club rescue boats include two rigid hull inflatables, one of which is equipped with a petrol driven pump.

14. Safety:

14.1 All participating boats and operators of such boats must comply with the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994* (The Act) and subordinate Regulation (The Reg).

14.2 The *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) will apply only between those boats that are participating in the event, for the duration of the event. Should interaction occur with non-participating boats the COLREGS shall apply and over-ride all other rules.

14.3 In particular, attention is drawn to Rule 9 – '**Narrow Channels**':- **A sailing vessel shall not impede the passage of a vessel which can safely navigate only in a narrow channel of fairway.**

14.4 RACE PARTICIPANTS ARE TO GIVE WAY AND ARE NOT TO HINDER ANY MOVEMENTS OF COMMERCIAL SHIPPING OR CITYCAT FERRIES.

14.5 All other safety requirements as per Sailing Instructions.

15. Prizes

Prizes to be awarded are as follows:

15.1 Overall Winner. 2nd and 3rd Overall.

15.2 Overall Handicap Winner. 2nd and 3rd Overall Handicap.

15.3 Presentation of Trophies will be held upstairs in the Clubhouse Monday 7th May at 17:00 .

16. Insurance:

All boats shall have current Third-Party Insurance with a racing cover considered by the insurer as adequate for the risks involved. Minimum AUD \$5 million. (recommended AUD \$10 million) or equivalent thereof for any incident.

ENTRY DECLARATION



OWNERS RESPONSIBILITY

The owner and the person in charge must ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained and stowed and that the crew knows where it is kept and how to it is to be used.

Neither the establishment of the Special Regulations, their use by Race Organisers, or the inspection of a boat under these Special Regulations in any way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of the owner and the person in charge.
